About us- Youthnet was formed in 1969 by a group of Skagit County concerned citizens, representatives from the juvenile court, public schools, State Social and Health Services and other community agencies.

In 1976, Skagit Alternative
School, the now named Emerson
High School first opened its
doors to students. Located in
Mount Vernon, Emerson has
expanded to serve Skagit County
youth with divergent educational
needs, primarily from the Mount
Vernon and La Conner School
Districts.

In the 1990's the agency also began offering Family Preservation Services to families who were at high risk of entering the foster care system and today we continue to offer the following:

Youthnet is a nonprofit organization that provides a support network for our at-risk youth and families. Youthnet also administers Emerson High School, the alternative high school in Mount Vernon. This position has two aspects: administering the high school and sharing the Youthnet administrative tasks with the co-director.

About Emerson High School

Emerson High School provides two programs:

- Core Program
- Contract Based Program

Upon completion of their home District graduation requirements, students are awarded a regular high school diploma from their resident District.

Emerson's class sizes are smaller, the students enjoy a higher level of interaction with teachers and peers. Students also participate in a wide array of community events and provide volunteer service to the community.

Emerson currently employs both full and part-time State certified teachers, counselors, a student support specialist, part-time registrar, attendance/registrar assistant and program administrator.
