Host a Fundraiser

Here are just a few ideas that have been successful for our community partners:



Fitness Challenge

Challenge co-workers to a fitness competition.
Run 30 miles in 30 days as a group. For every mile exceeded, each individual dedicates \$10 to a child in foster care (Top team can be arranged to win Youthnet swag)



Hospitality Day/ Night

If you are a restaurant, bar, or café dedicate a day where your local business can have an impact that counts. For example, from 4-8 pm 24% of your proceeds go back to youth and children in foster care.



Car Wash

Do you know anyone still in school? Have them coordinate a car wash with their academic peers or student club and donate the proceeds back to a specific Youthnet program.
